Paul J. “Page” Hoyer’s distinguished career began with a consulting firm that focused on problems at the intersection of finance, technology, and law for clients in the high tech and aerospace industries. He taught at several law schools to include Stanford Law School and the University of Southern California.

In 1993 he was selected to serve on the Defense Science Board (DSB) Task Force on Acquisition Reform. From 1996 to 1998, Mr. Hoyer was Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (International and Commercial Programs) and was then confirmed by the US Senate as Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics and Technology) in 1998. In this position he was the Senior Procurement Executive, the Science Advisor to the Secretary, and the senior research and development official for the Department of the Army.

Mr. Hoyer left government service in 2000, focusing on corporate governance and board service. He served on the Audit Committees of both public and private boards, and has been designated as an audit committee financial expert. He continues to be active in public service, serving on the board of Advanced Technology International, a not-for-profit corporation focused on expanding the knowledge economy in South Carolina. He is a member of the Pentagon’s Defense Science Board and chaired the DSB’s recent study on the cyber supply chain.

Mr. Hoyer received his B.S.E. in Basic Engineering from Princeton University and his M.A.T. (Mathematics) from Harvard University. In his leisure time, Mr. Hoyer enjoys competitive tennis, fly-fishing, and practicing the piano. He is married and has two children.
